



The WSIS Trust Fund was established in 2011 with the adoption of <u>Plenipotentiary</u> <u>Conference Resolution 140</u>.

Council Resolution <u>1332</u> as modified by ITU Council 2024 takes into account the outcomes of the United Nations General Assembly Overall Review of the Implementation of WSIS Outcomes and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, and resolves to maintain the fund to support ITU activities to facilitate the implementation of WSIS outcomes, calls for partnerships and strategic alliances, and invites the ITU Membership to make voluntary contributions to the fund.


