- Officially co-organized with the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU) and the Parliament of the Host Country.
- Outcomes: the IGF Parliamentary Track output document

Parliamentary Track at the global IGF 2025

- Official Parliamentary Track invitation letters to be sent out by the IPU by end of February
- Programme development as of mid-February and based on IGF 2024 feedback and input received from Members of Parliament
 - Dedicated, open Parliamentary Track sessions over a course of 2 days
 - Further integrating Members of Parliaments in other IGF sessions
- Outcomes: the IGF Parliamentary Track output document

Plans for 2025

- Further collaborate with the joint UNDP-IPU initiative to align Parliamentary initiatives among the UN system, Parliamentary Associations and partners of the digital ecosystem (curate a repository and share reports, upcoming events).
