According to the answers received in 217 proposals, the distribution of the answers to this question is:

	Alone	W/Others	Total
Best Practice Forums	3	11	14
Dynamic Coalitions	7	21	28
National, Regional and Youth IGF Initiatives	36	32	68
Policy Networks	10	16	26

“W/others” means that the intersessional question was multiple choices, so proponents could select more than one.

So, both as standalone and with other options, BPF (Best Practice Forum) appeared in 14 cases, DC (Dynamic Coalition) in 28, NRI (National, Regional and Youth IGF Initiatives) in 68 and PN (Policy Networks) in 26 cases, all from 217 responses.

Recommendations

- In order to establish a direct relationship with some specific intersessional work, the question could be reformulated to one choice response, stating the specific BPF, DC, NRI or PN to which the proposal is related.
- These results could be processed and shared with the intersessional teams, after the workshop have been selected by the MAG and before the IGF, so there is time to coordinate any other activity.
